To Help Deer, Don't Feed Them

Feeding Deer Can Do More Harm Than Good



"People who feed deer do more harm than good," said Trina Lynch, a district wildlife manager with the Colorado Parks and Wildlife. According to Lynch, there are several reasons why a Colorado law passed in 1992 makes it illegal to feed big game animals. One important reason is that deer are the primary prey of mountain lions. "Concentrating deer by feeding can attract mountain lions well within the city limits. It may become necessary to kill these lions for public safety," she said.

The normal feeding behavior of big game animals allows them to spread out as they graze or browse. Artificial feeding disrupts that behavior and prompts deer to crowd together in small areas where they are more likely to be chased by dogs and hit by cars.

Helping us to be "Fire Wise"

Fire season has officially started and we need your help to keep you and the resort safe.

Ways that you can help us stay fire wise.

- Please make sure that you have your bucket and shovel at your campsite at all times. To keep small animals from falling into your bucket, we suggest that you turn your buckets upside down.
- Campfires must be contained in proper designated pits (2` deep by 3` wide)with all combustible material removed 9-feet from your fire,this includes overhanging branches.
- Fires must be extinguished whenever an adult is not present at the campsite.

Use extreme caution with all campfires.

During extreme dry periods campfires may be banned. If so, a sign will be posted at the entrance of the main gate. Please if you are not sure if you may have a campfire, feel free to contact the main office.

Fishing Activity Report

We ask that whether you are catch-and-release fishing or catch-and-keep fishing, that a "Fishing Activity Report" be filled out. For all fishing activity on the Resort we would like to capture a few key pieces of information:

1. How much time is spent fishing at each lake. (Whether catch and keep, catch and release, or any combination of the two).
2. How many fish were kept, and/or released.
3. How many individuals were fishing at the lakes, example: you and a guest, 3 members of the family, etc.

For your convenience, there are clear plastic holders mounted at the

electronic entrance gate and at every lake. These holders have fishing activity reports which should be filled out by every member for every lake. The report is self-explanatory and once filled out can be dropped off in any of the clear plastic holders or at the exit gate on your way out.






